

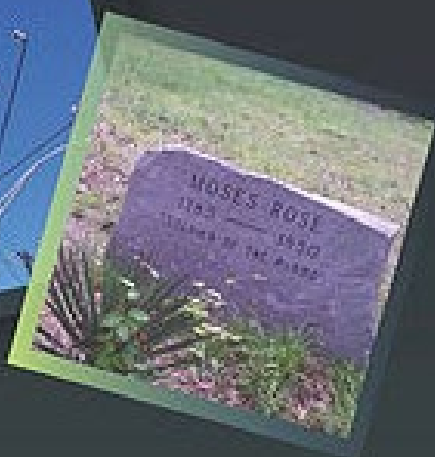
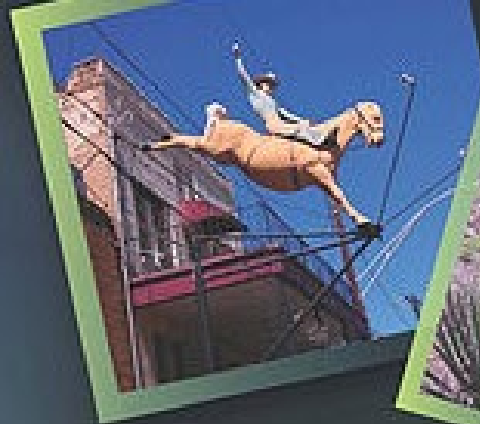

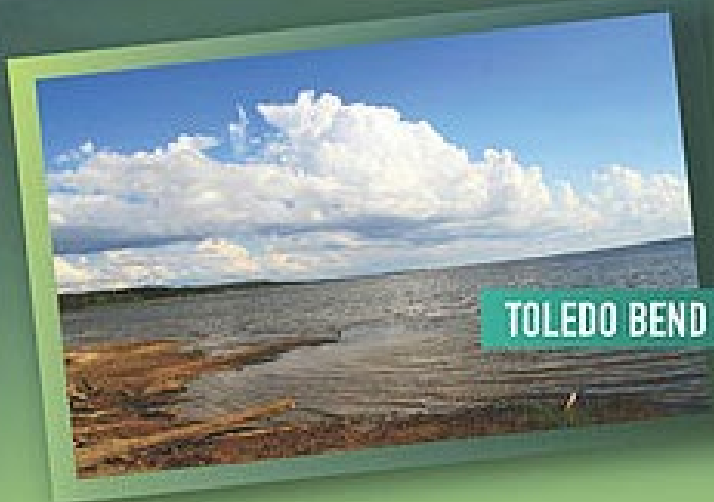

Just 30 minutes from **SHREVEPORT'S** shows and riverboats to the north and 30 minutes south to Natchitoches, established in 1714, and the **CANE RIVER** plantations.

Over 30 structures in DeSoto Parish are listed on the **NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES**. You can even find the grave of **MOSES ROSE**, the famous survivor of the Alamo. There's a reason movies are made here.

*T*here's a whole world of history awaiting you in northwest Louisiana. Discover **DESOTO PARISH**, on the northwest boundary of the Louisiana/Texas line. From natural areas like **TOLEDO BEND LAKE** to living history reenactments at Civil War battlefields to small-town Americana, you'll find an authentic experience that harkens back to a slower, kinder time.

Drive through lush, rolling piney woods, see beautiful mid-19th century Greek Revival architecture, pick ripe berries in season, explore historic cemeteries, or simply shop at some of our small town stores. Eat hot water cornbread or Southern fried fish from the **SABINE RIVER**, stay at a hotel, B&B, or bicycle on our many paved roads through the countryside.
